**AMENDED ORDINANCE**

**“BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF ADAIR COUNTY,  
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY”**

**AN ORDINANCE PROTECTING THE HEALTH, WELFARE,  
AND SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS OF ADAIR COUNTY  
THROUGH THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES**

**SECTION 1-DEFINITIONS:**

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply unless the Context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

**AUTOMOBILE PARTS** – Any portion or parts of any motor driven vehicle as detached from the vehicle as a whole.

**DWELLING** – Any part of any building or its premises used as a place of residence or habitation or for sleeping by any person.

**ILLEGAL DUMP** – Any location or facility that is not a solid waste site or facility for the disposal of specific wastes that is located, designated, constructed, operated, maintained, and closed in conformance with 401 KAR Chapter 47 and 48, and 401 KAR 30:031, and receives a case-by-case design review by the cabinet.

**INOPERATIVE CONDITION** – Unable to move under its own power due to defective or missing parts and which has remained in such condition for a period of not less than sixty consecutive days, or, a vehicle that is not properly licensed registered and insured per state statutes.

**MOTOR VEHICLE** – Any style or type of motor driven vehicle used for conveyance of persons or property, which is required to be registered, licensed registered and insured per state statutes.

**POPULATED AREA** – A density of homes exceeding 4 in a 1/10 mile radius.

**PUBLIC NUISANCE** - Any act, thing, occupation, condition, use of property, non-use of property, misuse of property that continues for a length of time so as to substantially annoy, injure, or endanger the comfort, health, repose or safety of the public;

**SCRAP METAL** – Pieces or parts of steel, iron, tin, zinc, copper, aluminum, or any alloy thereof, whether covered with porcelain or any other material, whether intact or in parts, which has served its usefulness in its original form and can not longer be used for its originally intended purpose.
